We are delighted you're thinking of Baptism for your child. Your child is precious to you and precious to God. At Baptism you promise to raise your child to know God loves them, and to help them to follow Jesus as a member of the Church.

We are all on a journey through life. Christians believe that we do not travel alone. God is both the starting point and the ending point, the alpha and the Omega. So the journey we take is an accompanied one. God is with us every step of the way and Baptism marks the beginning of that journey with God, whether as a child or as an adult.

If the child is not old enough to make promises and commitments for itself, the parents and godparents make the promises on its behalf.

Baptisms normally take place in our main Sunday service, so the Church Community can see your child join the church and welcome them in.

Normally there are two or three godparents, usually chosen with great care so that they have something to offer the child which is quite unique. They can be family members or friends, but they do need to be baptised themselves to be able to do their job properly. If you wish other people to be involved, they could act as sponsors.
